



Safety Policies & Procedures

We are following the rules of our host golf courses, parks & rec. departments, cities, counties (e.g., [SCCPH](#)), and state as we determine our safety policies, which are subject to change.

General Rules for Everyone

Nobody is allowed to attend class if they show any signs of illness or test positive for COVID-19. If you were deemed a [close contact](#) to a person positive with COVID-19, or have tested positive for COVID-19, please follow the SCCPH [COVID-19 guidelines](#). Anyone who appears sick during class may be removed or asked to leave class.

- Those eligible are strongly urged to [get vaccinated against COVID-19](#) ASAP. (FTSV will continue to ascertain the [vaccination status](#) of all volunteers and staff.)
- Those who are not fully vaccinated should obtain weekly [testing for COVID-19](#).
- [Face coverings are not required, but strongly recommended](#) even if you are vaccinated, especially if unable to be physically distanced or indoors.
- Maintain six feet of physical distance whenever and wherever possible.
- Sanitize shared clubs and equipment before and after use.
- Cover your mouth when sneezing or coughing.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Wash or disinfect hands frequently.
- Do not share any food or drinks.

Class Check-In

1. Please be on time. Given safety protocols, we must be especially disciplined.
2. The FTSV gate at Rancho is separate from the public to the left of the clubhouse.
3. The check-in line will have separate lines for each class and require people to stand 6ft apart (follow designated colored dots on ground).
4. Parent/guardians must be present along with their child to sign-in and sign-out [unless](#) your child is qualified and marked as "self-check in"
5. Parents may not enter Rancho via the FTSV gate.
6. Parents may not be within 20 yards of their child's class.
7. Hand sanitizers will be available at the check-in table while supplies last.



Class Time

1. Coaches carry a designated FTSV first aid bag.
2. Part 1 classes will warm up together, then be divided into two groups after 10 minutes. One group will go to the driving range and one to the putting green to help with physical distancing.
3. Participants who are not hitting will be spaced out 3 yards in their safety zones behind hitting stations.
4. Show respect for others by using their preferred greeting – handshake, knuckle bump, air high-five or wave.

Class Check Out

1. Instructors check out their small group by walking them back to the check-in area.
2. Instructors will field questions at the question table (next to the check-out table) after everyone checks out. Please remain six feet apart.
