Scholarships Awarded By First Tee

1) Joyce Taylor Eagle Award

- \$5,000 scholarship that FTSV awards on an annual basis to a high school student who is an active participant in FTSV planning on attending a 2 or 4-year university/college.
- Participants are selected for this scholarship by the FTSV Program Team.
- Selection criteria includes need, time spent in the program, number of classes taken, volunteer hours, & demonstration of going above & beyond.

2) Dennis Kettman Eagle Award

- \$5,000 scholarship that FTSV awards on an annual basis to a high school student who is an active participant planning on attending a 2 or 4-year university/college.

3) First Tee College Scholarship Program

- Up to \$20,000 scholarship, mentorship throughout college, professional development workshops, and job/internship assistance awarded by First Tee Headquarters (FTHQ) in Florida.
- Requirements to apply:
 - Highschool senior, minimum 3.3gpa, intent to attend 4-year university, active participant in FTSV, evidence of volunteerism and meaningful involvement in community, and financial need.
- In January of each year, FTSV invites qualified individuals to apply for the national First Tee scholarship opportunity.
- The application consists of essays, personal contact information, grade transcripts, and a letter of recommendation.
- FTHQ selects a few participants from the around the country each year

1) Youth On Course (YOC)

- YOC awards up to 25 scholarships every year, ranging from \$4,000 - \$20,000 to active YOC members who are high school seniors
- Requirements to apply:
