



Core Curriculum Details

Core Curriculum:

There are three parts to the core curriculum – Life Skills, Golf Cues, Golf Ready

1. Life Skills –

- Six life skills taught across all grade groups
- Life Skills include: Showing Respect, Collaborating with Others, Building Positive Self-Identity, Making Good Choices, Setting Goals, Overcoming Challenges
- Each Life Skill has four related life tools (each with three tips) -- one for each grade group (i.e., 24 total life lessons)

2. Golf Cues –

- We use our Golf Cues to teach golf skills (i.e., putting, chipping, pitching, full swing, play)
- Six Golf Cues taught across all grade groups
- Golf Cues correspond to parts of the body important to golf skill development – Hands, Arms, Torso, Head, Feet, Legs
- Each Golf Cue has four related golf tools (each with three tips) -- one for each grade group (i.e., 24 total golf lessons)

3. Golf Ready –

- Six Golf Ready categories taught across all grade groups
- Golf Ready categories include: Etiquette, Safety, Spaces, Pace, Rules – General, Rules – Competitive
- Each Golf Ready category has four related golf tools – one for each grade group (i.e., 24 total golf ready lessons).
